<u>Sub: Help remove Confusion among Indian Medical Students Studying from Ukraine</u>

Respected Madam,

This has reference to the Notification available on the website of Indian Embassy, Kiev, Ukraine at

https://www.eoiukraine.gov.in/pdf/press%20release%20USQE.pdf that says the Government of Ukraine is going to conduct various examinations in India for Indian Medical students studying online in various medical universities of Ukraine (Annexure Page 1).

Another point of reference is the recent judgment by the Hon'ble Supreme Court (Annexure - Page 2 to page 10) about Foreign Medical Graduates qualifying their final year examinations to be conducted or organized by Government of India or the National Medical Commission in 2 attempts.

Question arises - Where is the confusion I am talking about?

The students completing medical education in Ukraine are worried as to what they shall do.

Shall they appear for the examinations being conducted by The Government of Ukraine or the examination being conducted by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and the National Medical Commission?

Here I want to submit that since the Government of Ukraine is ready to conduct examinations of Indian Medical students in India.

I believe it will be better for the National Medical Commission to coordinate with the Government of Ukraine through the Embassy of India in Kiev, Ukraine for the same in the interest of not only students but in the interest of the country and let coordinate and HELP SUPPORT the Government of Ukraine conduct the examinations in India as desired by them.

Since the above order has been issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, formalities to take permission if needed can be done by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and the National Medical Commission.

As is mentioned that the students will have to undergo 1 year free and 1 year paid internship.

I believe it will be better if possible for the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and the National Medical Commission the students instead of 1 year paid internship be asked to FIRST attend 1 year of paid practical training of relevant subjects of offline classes they missed in various medical, dental and nursing colleges of India; Followed by 1 year of free internship. That will reduce the deficiency of practical knowledge among the students.

Hope my letter will be taken into consideration while issuing the final notification and procedures by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and the National Medical Commission.

Government of Ukraine adopted a Resolution allowing conduct of Unified State Qualification Exam (USQE) outside Ukraine

Considering that many students undergoing medical education in Ukraine were forced to leave Ukraine and are currently unable to return because of the current security situation and martial law imposed in the country, the Government of Ukraine has adopted a decree (https://cutt.ly/A42q043) on 28 March 2023 "On amendments to the procedure for conducting a Unified State Qualification Exam (USQE) for graduates of Master's Degree in Healthcare", which will allow students to take the USQE outside of Ukraine in places of their permanent residence/temporary stay during the period of martial law.

The USQE includes following examinations:

- Integrated Test Exam "KROK";
- · Objective Structured Practical (Clinical) Exam; and
- Professional English Language Exam.

The aforesaid decree will give an opportunity to the students living outside Ukraine to take KROK Examination at testing centers recognized by the State Non-Profit Enterprise "Testing Board for Professional Competence Assessment of Higher Education Trainees in Medicine and Pharmacy at the Ministry of Public Health of Ukraine", in the respective countries of their stay, including India, and in respect of students who are in Ukraine - at the domestic institutions of higher education.

UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following ORDER

W.P.(C) No. 25/2023 (ITEM NO.40.10)

The only grievance of the petitioners in this petition is that some of the petitioners would be required to undergo one more year of internship so as to enable them to practice in India.

- 2. Mr. Shivam Singh, learned counsel for the petitioners, submits that some of the petitioners have already undergone one year of internship. The course to be undertaken in the second year of internship is also identical with the first year of internship.
- 3. We find that the requirement of undergoing one more year of internship cannot be said to be arbitrary or unreasonable.
- 4. The writ petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
- 5. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.

W.P.(C) No. 667/2022 & W.P.(C) No.679/2022 (ITEM NOS.40.21 & 40,22)

- 1. The grievance of the petitioners is that they being enrolled in foreign universities in medical courses, are attending online classes. It is submitted that for the first four years there is no requirement of clinical training and that is required only in the fifth and sixth year of the course.
- 2. Shri Ravi Sikri, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioners, submits that in the affidavit filed by the Central Government there is no provision for such students.
- 3. We find that the grievance is totally pre-mature in nature, inasmuch as only after the petitioners complete their MBBS course and have a degree of MBBS from the respective foreign universities, the question whether they are entitled to appear for Foreign Medical Graduates Examination (FMGE) or not would arise.
- 4. We do not find it necessary to consider the said question at this stage.
- 5. Insofar as the students who were required to leave the studies in the penultimate year are concerned, the affidavit filed by the

Union of India dated 27.03.2023 takes care of such students.



- 6. With the aforesaid observations, these petitions stand disposed of.
- 7. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.

REST OF THE MATTERS

- 1. As already observed in our earlier order dated 09.12.2022, in normal circumstances we would not have entertained such petitions. However, taking into consideration a precarious situation, where the career of hundreds of students would have come to a standstill, the present petitions were treated as extraordinary petitions and this Court had passed an order directing the Committee appointed by the Union of India to examine the issue and come with some solutions.
- 2. An affidavit dated 27.03.2023, on behalf of the Union of India, along with the brief note about the three meetings held by the Committee, as annexure in that affidavit, has been handed over in Court by Ms. Aishwarya Bhati, learned Additional Solicitor General of India, which is taken on record.
- 3. Though we do not find it appropriate to interfere with the decision of the experts, there is one area of concern, which, in our view, requires consideration. The embargo of having an opportunity to appear only in one attempt, in our view, may in some circumstances appear to be too harsh. There could be certain circumstances beyond the control of the student, which may prevent him/her from appearing in the examination or passing the said

examination.



- 4. Ms. Aishwarya Bhati, learned Additional Solicitor General of India as well as Mr. Gaurav Sharma, learned counsel appearing for the NMC, fairly submit that they are not treating this litigation as an adversarial litigation. They submit that if the Court finds that the said restriction is unreasonable, they leave it to the Court to pass appropriate directions.
- 5. We, therefore, accept the report of the Committee, subject to a minor modification in paragraph 5(1) of the Compliance Affidavit dated 27.03.2023 by the Union of India. In the said paragraph 5(1), the words "The students may be offered a single chance to clear the MBBS Final, both Part I & Part II Examinations (Both Theory and Practical)" be read as "The students may be offered two chances to clear the MBBS Final, both Part I & Part II Examinations (Both Theory and Practical)".
- 6. We clarify that the two chances would be both for Part I as well as Part II examinations, each.
- 7. With the above observations and directions, these petitions stand disposed of.
- 8. Pending applications, including applications for impleadment/intervention shall stand disposed of.
